The following pages are a review of what we have achieved together in this ten month period, along with our ever growing list of thank yous.

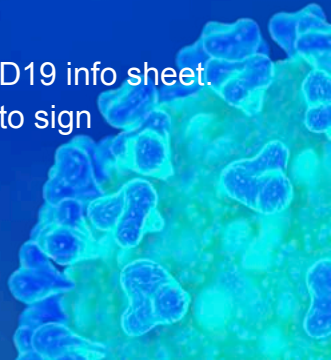

01. COMMUNICATION & INFORMATION

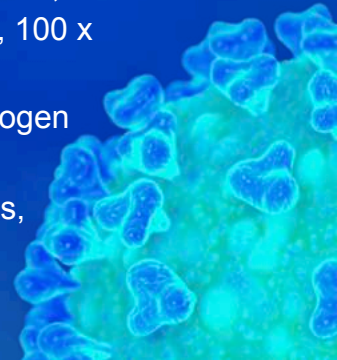
From the beginning, the best tool in the fight against COVID-19 has been prevention through information dissemination

- This was undertaken as follows
 - Council loudhailer announcements
 - Council sensitisation of local government entities
 - Council sensitisation of communal gathering places
 - Set up of Whatsapp groups disseminating MoHCC & WHO approved information and town updates
 - Set up of public Facebook page with same information as above
 - Set up of Twitter page to disseminate information & update public on taskforce actions
 - Flyer printing and distribution throughout areas with limited access to internet
 - Prior to lockdown, verbal discussion with informal groups
 - EHT sensitisation of businesses and tourism players
 - Distribution online of COVID-19 related health advice in multiple languages (Shona, Ndebele, Tonga, English, Nambiya, Kalanga)
- Dedicated Hotline to Victoria Falls Hospital set up for COVID19 symptoms reporting
- Media Liaison with interested parties
- 210 Information & hygiene packs distributed to returnees at border, consisting of mask, soap and COVID19 info sheet.
- 200 information & hygiene packs distributed to the disabled members of VIFADIPEA, with translation into sign language by their committee
- Large scale information dissemination by local NGO groups in surrounding rural areas
- Distribution of COVID-19 information posters in urban and rural areas through Council, EHT and NGOs



02. TREATMENT CENTRES & VICTORIA FALLS HOSPITAL

- Adaptation of ZAPS Base AIDS clinic & the Victoria Falls Municipality Mkhosana Clinic to meet COVID-19 standards for treatment centres (water tanks, plumbing (toilets & showers), geysers, sewerage tanks, electrics, paint, area upgrades, generator repairs)
- Oxygen therapy equipment through loan, donation and purchase include 3 x OxERA masks, 2 x mini vents, 2 x CPAP ventilators, 1 x oxygen concentrator, 4 x double flowmeters 1 x large oxygen tank pin regulator, 1 x suction machine, 1 x distilled water machine, 180 x non-rebreather oxygen masks, 180 x nasal cannula, 180 x oxygen connectors, 30 x humidifiers, 3 x reusable CPAP masks,
- Diagnostic equipment includes Istat analysis machine with cartridges, portable digital X-ray machine, 25 x pulse oximeters, 1 x GeneXpert, 1 x glucometer, 1 x blood pressure machine
- Medication stocks for pharmacy including dexamethasone, azithromycin, zinc, Vit D and ceftriaxone
- Assorted medical supplies including ECG electrodes, 14 x electronic thermometers
- Personal Protection Equipment sourced and purchased – 2522 x Tyvek coveralls, 878 x faceshields, 498 x goggles, 10 258 x medical masks, 2311 x N95 grade medical masks, 4500 x latex gloves, 2000 x theater shoe covers, 2010 x theater hair caps, 500 x nitrile/heavy duty gloves, 100 x heavy-duty aprons, 94 x gumboots, 98 x heavy duty PVC suits, 30 x dustcoats, 89 x doctors scrubs, 450 x surgical gowns, 249 x patient gowns, 100 x plastic aprons
- Disinfectant & cleaning materials include 400kg x Multichlor, 100l x bleach, 240l x sanitiser, 60l x hydrogen peroxide, 20l enzymatic cleaner, assorted Jik/other, mops and cleaning items
- Bed mattresses recovered, linen and blankets, cleaning & bio-hazard waste containers, kitchen utensils, equipment & fridges

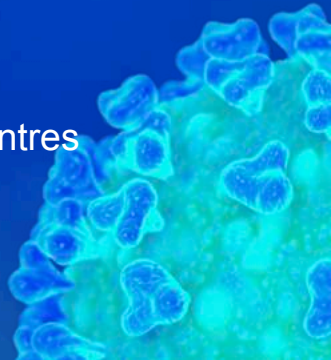


02. TREATMENT CENTRES & VICTORIA FALLS HOSPITAL

- High Dependency Unit at Victoria Falls Hospital renovated to COVID-19 standards – negative pressure air extraction system, corridor doors, interior doors and windows in nurses station, addition of shower and toilet, shelving in sluice/storage room, air-conditioner in nurses station, geyser
- Laundry at VF Hospital fully operational and connected with new geyser to meet COVID-19 standards
- Hospital and grounds cleaned, store rooms emptied and sorted, refuse pits dug under Food for Work Scheme
- Constant refilling of town oxygen tanks (hospital, council, emergency services & private doctors). To date 49 tanks have been filled in Hwange
- Loan of vehicles and drivers to assist Rapid Response Teams
- Repair of ambulance
- 1330l x Fuel (diesel & petrol) for ambulances and response vehicles
- 14 x motorbikes repaired and serviced
- EHT team transported for training
- Island Hospice training for medical workers and pastors group

COVID-19 patient records from end March 2020 to date:

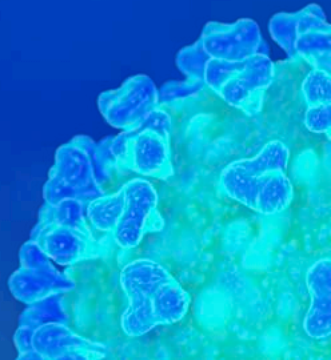
- 163 home self-isolating patients have been assisted for free with medication
- 145 mild to severely ill patients have been treated and stabilised at the two treatment centres
- 2 deaths at the treatment centres (both comorbidities) and one community death



03. ADVOCACY & LOBBYING

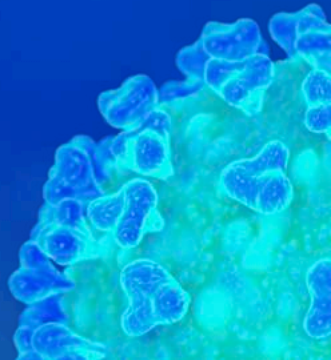

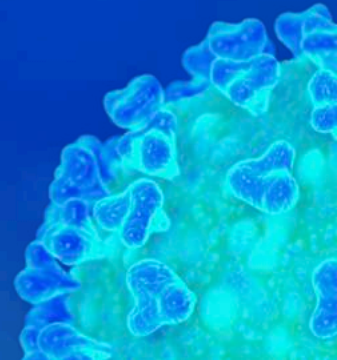
04. FINANCE & RESOURCES

- The Finance and Resources taskforce Group focused on setting up donation sites on platforms Go Fund Me for medical equipment and JustGiving for food security
- The Jafuta Foundation, a Zimbabwe registered Trust operating in the Victoria Falls region, lent it's support and resources to administer and ensure transparency and correct deployment of funds and donations raised through these platforms.
- Monetary donations locally were managed by accountants, again under the aegis of Jafuta Foundation.
- Physical donations and equipment loans are recorded and distributed by the taskforce under Acting DMO supervision
- The Go Fund Me for medical equipment has been closed, having raised \$18 696 online, with other donations coming through in cash and kind.
- In total, to date funds raised total \$ 107 938 of which \$91 963, 53 has been used to purchase medical equipment and PPE as well as outfit the VF Hospital ICU. The balance is planned for the completion of the ICU fit out.
- Donations in kind (not inclusive of community donations of second goods) total \$119 379 in value.
- Pick n Pay kindly donated food vouchers worth \$2257.
- In total this all comes to a value of \$ 229 574 raised by the Taskforce.



05. PROCUREMENT & LOGISTICS

- The sourcing of medical equipment, disinfectant, sanitisers and PPE goods has been an ongoing challenge due to the shortage of supplies worldwide and the limited transport options available
- To this end, the procurement taskforce has been concentrating on supplies available in Harare and South Africa.
- To date they have sourced all goods listed - PPE sets, bulk disinfectant and medical equipment and sundries
- The urgent need to source further goods will continue throughout the development of the pandemic in the area but is very dependent on funds remaining and further fund raising activities
- SWIFT Zimbabwe has been instrumental in offering lowered rates and even free transport for donations from Harare and we look to continue this working relationship
- The Acting DMO and team have been constantly assessing availability of goods and medicines through NatPharm and ordering where possible



06. PUBLIC WORK & MAINTENANCE

Victoria Falls Municipality has fully committed to the aims of the taskforce

- To date they have Allocated Mkhosana Clinic to be an isolation centre, undertaking plumbing at the centre; Repaired high traffic roads to isolation centres; Undertaken public information campaigns as outlined in Communications section; Undertaken public sanitisation of high traffic areas with backpack sprayers, using PPE sets and disinfectant donated or purchased through public donations; A mass disinfection program by water cannon, using disinfectant donated from public funding; Municipal Clinics have reconfigured to allow for the use of Mkhosana Clinic as an isolation centre. All Municipal staff are fully briefed in COVID19 prevention and case management procedures; Chinotimba Old Aged Home was and continues to be isolated since the 15th March; High priority is being given to continuous safe water and electricity supply especially at treatment centres
- Municipality have worked hand in hand with Public Works to upgrade the VF Hospital ICU, complementing each others workforce
- Excellent lines of communication remain open between JOC, the taskforce, MoHCC, MoPW and the community thanks to their leading role

To date, Taskforce has supplied Municipality with:

60l x hydrogen peroxide, 20 x heavy duty gloves, 100 x medical masks, 100 x latex gloves, 10 x reusable PVC suits for COVID burials, 10 x gumboots, 50 x N95 masks, 10 x goggles, cloth masks, promotional posters for prevention of COVID-19



07. PUBLIC SAFETY & SECURITY

- Under the Advocacy and Lobbying taskforce, strong lines of communication have been established with ZRP and ZNA locally and the area JOC.
- Clear emergency contact lines for ZRP have been distributed throughout the community
- The taskforce remains guided in all situations by Government and Security Forces and are directed at their discretion.
- ZRP and ZNA are currently protecting the valuable medical assets in the isolation centres and are posted at testing centres and quarantine at Budget Encore Hotel

To date, taskforce have supplied:

ZRP

Batteries for loudhailers, 8 x faceshields, 8 x goggles, 500 x medical masks, 300 x cotton recyclable masks

ZNA

8 x faceshields, 8 x goggles, 500 x cotton recyclable masks, 500 x medical masks

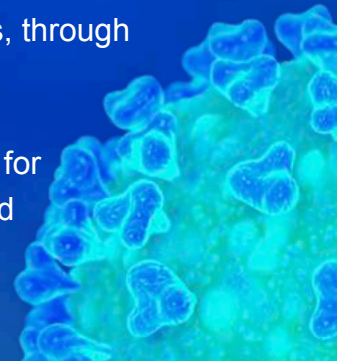

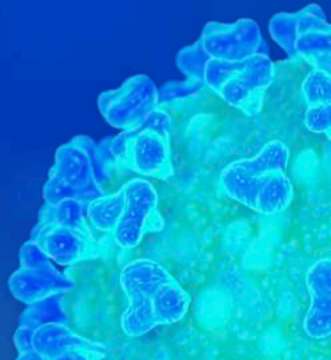
08. FOOD SECURITY

- Recognising the real threat of a food crisis caused by loss of income in the town which is heavily dependent on the tourism sector, a food security team was established with the aim of gathering reserves to ensure that there will be some support for vulnerable families.
- Engagement with national and international food relief agencies to request assistance, although nothing has materialised. Including WFP, Red Cross, DFID (uk) as well as GMB, social welfare, Access, Epap, Eat Out Zimbabwe etc.
- Commercial kitchens in Victoria Falls from restaurants and lodges ready and willing to assist with food preparation and storage (for soup kitchens or packages for vulnerable homes) pending donation of food supplies.
- Set up of fundraising appeal on <https://www.justgiving.com/crowdfunding/vicfallsfamine-appeal> as well as website and Instagram. Food collection points at the main supermarkets established have received a small quantity of non-perishable goods.
- Identification of vulnerable homes through ward Councillors, churches and other benevolent groups, although this focused on disabled, homeless, old and infirm, as opposed to vulnerable through recent job losses.
- Donation of 15 tonnes of rice through the MP's allocation was distributed across urban and rural wards, through the councillors for each ward.
- Rural food hampers to OVC and grandmother headed households also conducted by NGO partners.
- 'Feed yourself: Feed your community' Food Growing campaign in nascent stage involving a campaign for residents in rural and urban areas to grow vegetables where possible (limitations of water), collect seed



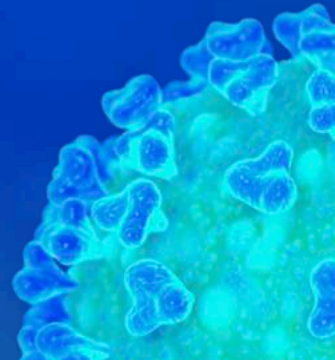
09. RURAL OUTREACH

- Existing NGOs expanded their field to offer COVID-19 awareness in their respective areas. It is through this vital support that rural communities were reached
- Community awareness in Shona, IsiNdebele, Kalanga, Tonga and Nambiya language through MOHCC approved posters, fliers and loud hailer in areas accessible by road.
- Construction of tippy taps and packages of soap (donated by hotels) at public boreholes in Chidobe and Kachetchete wards, distributed by Village Heads, Headman and NGOs working in the area. Sensitisation on the issue of boreholes being used communally and the need for sanitation at those points - some VH instituted a borehole attendant to inform others and sanitise after use.
- Soap, latex gloves, cotton masks and moringa powder distributed to staff at Chisuma and Ndlovu Clinics and healthcare workers by local NGOs.
- Working closely with Agritex & traditional leadership structure, identification of suitable sites for community gardens to promote food security, procurement of seed ongoing, discussion around how communities will be the first beneficiaries and can sell surplus to support the famine relief since their usual market of hotels has gone.
- NGOs such as CITW continue to distribute food aid throughout the areas they cover



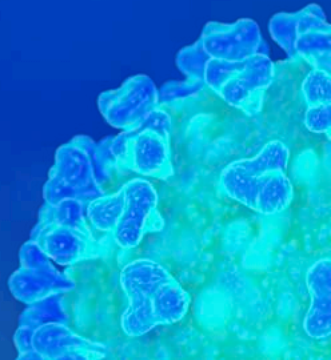
09. COMMUNITY PROJECTS

- A taskforce was been set up to coordinate production of homemade masks by individuals across the community, working with donated materials. They have produced and distributed 6000 masks including all given out as previously listed, 570 masks issued to our Ward Councillors for distribution with food relief; Masks to garage attendants; masks to ZESA workers; masks to school children and volunteers through the Children's Feeding Scheme; masks to the Old Age Home; Masks to anyone in the public in need
- Simple handwashing stations have been distributed throughout town, using the Tippy tap system.
- John Mpuhwa has recovered 6 isolation centre hospital beds and 10 pillows in waterproof fabric and sewn 6 x removable waterproof bedcovers for ICU, labour free of charge
- The Pastors Network continues in their wonderful work providing spiritual guidance to the community, counseling at hospitals & quarantine centres and food distribution to the needy, all whilst promoting good COVID19 hygiene practice. They are an integral part of the taskforce operation.
- Mummy's Angels continue their important work of assisting young mothers in need



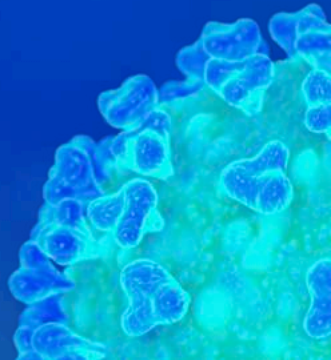
10. EMERGENCY RESPONSE CENTRE

- An Emergency Response Plan for Victoria Falls was drawn up with the acting DMO and local specialists, as per separate document. This plan will grow and evolve with the situation.



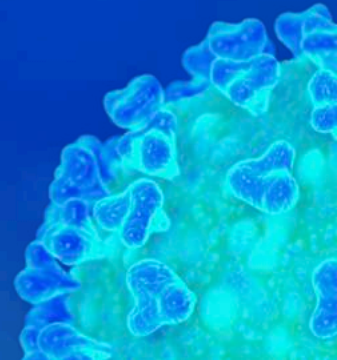
11. VOLUNTEER COORDINATION

- Under the conditions of lockdown, there has not been much volunteer activity to prevent COVID-19 spread
- Volunteers have unloaded food donations into storage
- Volunteers undertook to run the 'Food for work' program and the Children's Feeding Scheme, following closely all recommended health and hygiene conditions.



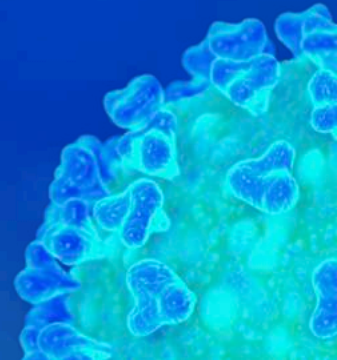
11. QUARANTINE CENTRE

- During the National Taskforce inspection of Victoria Falls preparedness, the local MoHCC team was instructed to identify and set up a quarantine centre in conjunction with MoPW. Mosi High School was originally selected, then when schools opened, it was moved to Budget Encore.
- Due to the short notice, that taskforce appealed to community members for second hand donations – donated were more than 45 blanket, sheet, pillow bedsets, baby products and food, food and cooking equipment, sanitary products for women, books, magazines and games and a DVD player and DVDs. Due to lack of funding, patients at isolation centres needed to be assisted by Taskforce – insulin, personal hygiene materials and food were donated. Over 200 COVID hygiene packs of mask, soap and info were given out.
- Shearwater Adventures have kindly loaned one to two buses with drivers to collect returnees from Kazungula every day as necessary. Fuel is provided by MoHCC



12. COMMUNITY RECOVERY


- Leaders in the Tourism industry have banded together under the Ministry of Tourism, Zimbabwe Tourism Board and ZTA to develop a strategy for Victoria Falls to be back in business as soon as possible once the pandemic is under control. This is an ongoing exercise as covers current situation communication with industry leaders. Plans have now finalised on two main platforms for the promotion of the destination once declared COVID19 free and open for business
- National Parks and VFAPU continue to undertake anti poaching activities in all the National Parks to ensure that the invaluable tourism resource of our wildlife is protected from poaching. Anti poaching teams have witnessed a large increase in incidents. They have drafted in several local professional guides as volunteers to increase their presence, as the need continues to grow.
- African Albida have created a fundraising platform for anti-poaching support.
